1. Состав государственной итоговой аттестации

Государственная итоговая аттестация по направлению подготовки 41.03.05 Международные отношения в соответствии с решением Ученого совета университета включает в себя:

- сдачу государственного экзамена

2. Программа государственного итогового экзамена

Комиссии по приему государственных экзаменов организуются под председательством руководителя (заместителя руководителя) организации. Члены приемной комиссии назначаются ее председателем из числа высококвалифицированных научно-педагогических и научных работников.

Заместитель председателя приемной комиссии выполняет функции председателя экзаменационной комиссии в случае его отсутствия.

В отсутствие председателя экзаменационной комиссии или заместителя председателя экзаменационной комиссии принимать экзамены экзаменационная комиссия не вправе. Комиссия правомочна принимать экзамены, если в ее заседании участвуют не менее двух специалистов по профилю принимаемого экзамена, в том числе один доктор наук. При этом в заседании экзаменационной комиссии по приему экзамена должны участвовать не менее $\frac{2}{3}$ ее состава. При приеме экзамена могут присутствовать члены соответствующего диссертационного совета организации, где принимается экзамен, руководитель (заместитель руководителя) организации, руководитель подразделения организации, представители Министерства образования и науки Российской Федерации или иного федерального органа исполнительной власти, в ведении которого находится данная организация.

Экзамены проводятся по усмотрению экзаменационной комиссии по билетам или без билетов в форме собеседования или в иной форме.

Для подготовки ответа экзаменуемые используют экзаменационные листы, которые сохраняются в организации после приема экзамена в течение года. Если форма проведения экзамена не предусматривает письменной подготовки, то экзаменационные листы не используются.

На каждого экзаменуемого заполняется протокол приема экзамена, в который вносятся вопросы билетов.
